Construction Begins: Summer 2025

Project Overview

Dorchester County proposes to replace the Pointer Drive bridge over an unnamed tributary to Dorchester Creek in Dorchester County, South Carolina. The bridge replacement is in the Quail Arbor neighborhood.

The proposed work consists of replacing the existing bridge with a new bridge which will include improved barriers and shoulders. A portion of Pointer Drive will be closed for up to 90 days during construction, and a detour will be in place.

Budget and Funding

Pointer Drive Bridge Replacement is one of three (3) bridges being replaced under the Design Build Bridges Project, which is funded by the Dorchester County Transportation Sales Tax and Stormwater Revenue Bond.

Total Design Build Bridges Project Budget: \$7,170,000
